SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Boundless by CSMA will organise a Clubmans permit Autotest on Sunday 2nd June 2019 at Grove Street Car Park, Coventry CV1 5DL.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
3. Motorsport UK Permit 113066..... has been issued.
4. The event is open to club members of Boundless by CSMA and invited clubs on a first come selection basis and to registered entrants in the following championships:
Motorsport UK British Autotest and Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest.
5. All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership card.
6. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:- Scrutineering starts at 08:30 and any competitor not signed on by 10:00 may be excluded. The first car will start at 10:00.
7. The event will consist of 6 classes as follows:-
 - Class A – Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length
 - Class B – Saloon Cars over 11ft overall length
 - Class C – Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
 - Class D – Specials
 - Class E – Road Going Cars
 - Class F – Road Going Kit Cars

Cabriolet saloons with the hood down will run in the appropriate sports car class. All cars must comply with the Motorsport UK tyre and vehicle regulations. **Note: 1B or 1C tyres will not be allowed.** All cars MUST be silenced. Overall length will be determined by the Parkers Used Car Guide, or if not given, by the manufacturers catalogue.

8. Awards will be presented as follows:-

Fastest Time of the Day		an award
1st in each class	(subject to 3 starters in class)	an award
2nd in each class	(subject to 6 starters in class)	an award
3rd in each class	(subject to 10 starters in class)	an award
Best Novice	(subject to 3 starters in class)	an award

All awards are perpetual. No competitor may win more than one award.

10. The maximum entry for the meeting is 40, the minimum 15. The maximum for each class is 20, the minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the Organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Entry fees will be refunded at organiser's discretion.

12. Results will be on display during the day and provisional results announced as soon as possible following the last finisher. Protests must be made within 15 minutes of the results being announced as provisional, otherwise they will be declared final and the awards presented. Results will be posted to all competitors.

13. Any protest must be made in accordance with Section C5.

14. (a) Details of tests will be sent with the Final Instructions.
(b) Each driver will have all times to count.
(c) Timing will be by hand held digital watches to 0.1 sec.
(d) The starting signal will be "in your own time".
(e) Order of attempting the tests will be numerical/class order.

15. Practising will NOT be allowed.

16. Competitors will be identified by organiser supplied numbers.

17. Marking and Penalties as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations:-

- M9.4 (c) incorrect test +20 seconds
(d) cones 5 seconds (e) lines 5 seconds

18. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following:-

H35.1.4 A Novice must not have won an award on an authorised autotest, other than a team award, since 01/06/14.

M5.1 In consequence of the whole event taking place on private property, vehicles need not be licensed.
